


LCA of a Glue and Metal Free Wooden Wall Element

Product Description





- Trade name: "holzpur"
 Producer: Walter Küng AG, Alpnach
- Wood: Spruce and fir from a regional forest
- Characteristics:
 - No nails or screws / glue / wood preservatives
 - Reinforced kraft paper for wind protection
 - Moisture content: 6%; Density: 420 kg/m³
- Application:
 - Wall element (mainly used for dwelling houses)

Goal and Scope



- Perform a LCA of holzpur wall elements
- Environmental indicators:
 - Total impacts according to the Ecological Scarcity Method 2013
 - Cumulative Energy Demand (total and non-renewable)
 - Greenhouse Gas Emissions according to IPCC 2013
- KBOB Recommendation:

Include environmental indicator results as producer-specific values in the next update of the KBOB recommendation


• Functional unit: 1 m³ of a holzpur wall element






Softwood in forest





























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LCI Modelling




• Data:

- Specific data for the whole supply chain (forest, sawmill, air/kiln drying, wall element production)
- Ecoinvent v2.2+ data for background processes
- Multi-Output processes:
 - Physical allocation (volume) for inputs of wood products (e.g., round / industrial / residual wood)
 - Economic allocation (volume and revenue) for common inputs and outputs (e.g., land occupation, power sawing)
- Disposal:
 - 50% recycling, 50% incineration

Ecological Scarcity 2013






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Cumulative Energy Demand





Conclusions

- holzpur is an innovative glue and metal free wall element
- Environmental impacts caused by holzpur are significantly lower than those of glued-laminated timber
- Non-renewable CED is significantly lower compared to solid wood because of use of renewable energy in wood drying and electricity
